PROPOSED LOCHLUICHART WIND FARM

The Trust's attention has been drawn to the proposed wind farm at Lochluichart, in the local authority area covered by The Highland Council.

I enclose a copy of the Trust's Renewable Energy Developments Policy, which sets out its general approach to this issue, together with its analysis of the national policy context and some additional background information.

The Trust is not able to get involved in commenting on this proposal in detail. However, the Trust has seen the powerful objections to this proposed development submitted by Scottish Natural Heritage and by the John Muir Trust, and is broadly sympathetic to the issues they raise, particularly regarding the impacts the proposed wind farm would have upon landscape in general and upon wild land in particular.
